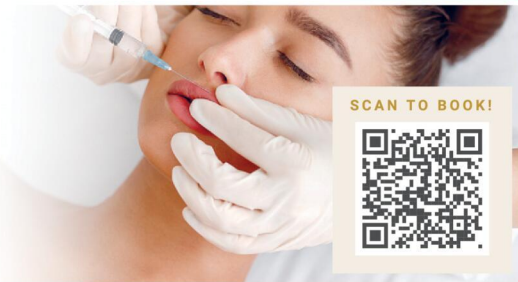

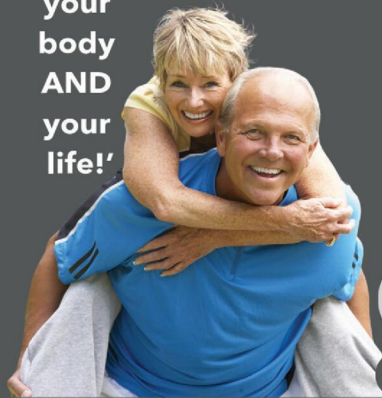

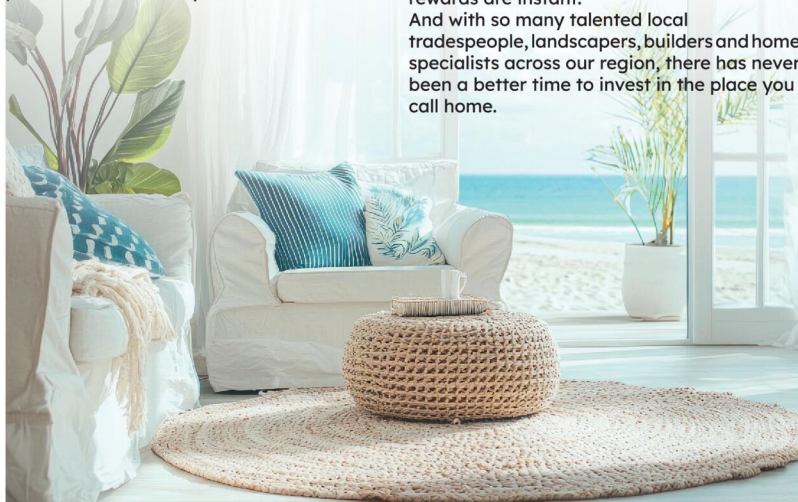

Why summer is the ideal time for roofing and guttering repairs

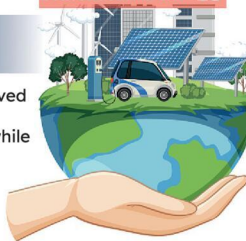

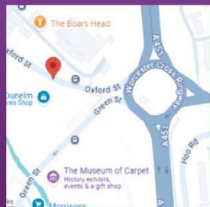

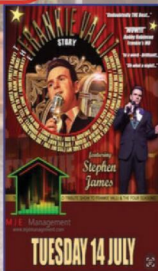

Get Out and About this Summer!

From music festivals and food fairs to riverside carnivals, outdoor concerts, classic car shows and family fun days, there is something happening almost every weekend across Worcestershire, Warwickshire and the West Midlands this summer. Whether you fancy browsing artisan markets in Malvern, dancing at a festival in Upton upon Severn, enjoying open-air concerts in Pershore or heading to Warwickshire for folk music, countryside shows and family events, 2026 is bursting with reasons to get out and about.
